I. International Congress of Quantum Chemistry

The XIIth International Congress of Quantum Chemistry (XII-ICQC2006) will be held at Kyoto, May 21-26, 2006, organized under the auspices of the International Academy of Quantum Molecular Science. The congress site is Kyoto TERRSA [1], which is located south close to Kyoto Station.

The Congress is held every three years and brings together scientists from all over the world. The first one was arranged 1973 at Menton (the headquarter of the Academy). Further sites were New Orleans, Kyoto, Uppsala, Montreal, Jerusalem, Menton, Prague, Atlanta, Menton, and Bonn. Major goals of the Congress are to provide an overview of recent novel developments, advances and directions of research in the broad area of quantum molecular sciences as well as to establish interaction between the theoretical discipline of quantum molecular science and experiment. Topics to be discussed cover a broad range of fields, from the development of fundamental methodologies to applications in a wide area of chemistry, biochemistry, pharmacology and molecular and solid state physics.

II. Poster presentation

All contributed papers will be presented as posters. “Best Poster Award” of ICQC2006 will be given for the best posters through public votes of all attendants. A participant who wants to present a poster is requested to submit an abstract by March 31, 2006.
